**Story Prompt Examples** 

Write about your favorite vacation.	Write about losing a friend.
Write your own version of a fairy tale or myth.	Write about a miscommunication.

Persuasive Prompt Examples

Pick something that many people do different ways (like boiling an egg or remembering the order of the planets) and persuade someone that your way is the most effective.	What is the most important part of a story: characters, plot, or some other element?
Is it okay for boys to play with toys made for girls and vice versa?	You are a teenager, I am 44. I envy you because you have the time to be anything you want to be. Am I right or wrong in thinking this way?
